

PLAYING IT SAFE

Glenview Park Golf Club and Glenview Prairie Club are open with a number of provisions to protect the safety of our customers, employees and our community.

We believe golf can be played at a safe physical distance outdoors and that it affords social, spiritual and mental health benefits that are vital to the well-being of golfers. We are committed to safety and have a plan in place allowing golfers to play with as little contact as possible while adhering to the guidelines set forth by the Illinois Department of Commerce & Economic Opportunity.

How THE EXPERIENCE has changed

- ✓ **Reservations Required**
To provide proper spacing and pace on the golf course, we are requiring an advanced tee time for all golfers. Golf Carts cannot be reserved in advance.
- ✓ **Play Limitations**
In accordance with state guidelines, reservations can now be made for up to 4 players per tee time. 18 Hole Play Only will be available daily with twilight beginning at 3pm. The course will close and all players must leave at posted closing time. 9 Hole play is available at Glenview Prairie Club
- ✓ **Tee Times**
Tee Times will continue at 10-minute tee time intervals.
- ✓ **Pre-Pay Only**
Pre-payment of tee times is required at the time the reservation is made. Players may book and prepay online or by calling the Golf Shop at (847) 724-0250. Pass Holders may book ONE tee time per day online. CREDIT CARDS ARE THE PREFERRED METHOD OF PAYMENT.
- ✓ **Pass Purchases**
League, 5- Day, 7-Day, 10, 25, and 50 Round Play can be purchased over the phone or at the Golf Shop.
- ✓ **The Golf Shop is Open**
For retail merchandise, cart and pass purchases. A Mask is required to enter the Clubhouse and Golf Shop.

How THE GAME & COURSE has changed

- ✓ **The Flag Stick**
Removing the Flag Stick is optional. If you do touch it, please sanitize your hands.
- ✓ **Riding Carts and Push Carts Are Available for Rent**
Per guidelines issued on June 26, 2021 two players will be allowed in the same golf cart. If two people who DO NOT live in the same household share a cart, both should face coverings while in the cart. Posted Cart Rental Fees Apply. Carts must remain in staging area until tee off and must be returned with all garbage and personal items removed to the Cart Return Area. Players are responsible for disinfecting their cart – disinfectant wipes are available for use.
- ✓ **Putting Green is Open**
Players must provide their own golf balls and must remain 6 ft. from all other players. Practice Net will be opening in the near future. Only TWO players are allowed in the net area at a time. Players must provide their own golf balls.
- ✓ **On Course Accessories are back but limited**
Bunker rakes, benches and trash cans have been returned to the golf course. Please replace divots, repair ball marks and use your foot to smooth out the sand if you do not use a rake.
- ✓ **On Course Bathrooms and Water Fountains**
Washrooms are open on the course however; drinking fountains are NOT available. Bottle Filler ONLY is available in the Clubhouse and on course. Bottled water is available for purchase.

How YOU CAN HELP keep it SAFE

- ✓ **Don't Play if you're Sick**
If you are experiencing cold or flu symptoms, have a fever, or have been exposed to someone with COVID-19 please stay home and protect other players.
- ✓ **Maintain Space with your playing partners**
High fives and handshakes are normally encouraged but for now keep your space from playing partners. Stay at least 6 feet away at tee boxes and greens, handle your own scorecard, ball and clubs.
- ✓ **Trash Receptacles are available**
Keep the course clean by carrying out anything that you carry onto the course.
- ✓ **Navigating the entrance**
All players arriving to the course should enter via the south sidewalk. Rental Cart Return Area is just off the 18th green. Please remain in the cart staging area and approach the Starter Hut more than 15 minutes prior to your tee time and approach the 1st tee when called by the starter.
- ✓ **Bring your own hand sanitizer**
Help keep your partner and other players safe and sanitize your hands frequently.
- ✓ **Stray Balls**
Please respect our neighbors – do not retrieve any balls that are hit off course.
- ✓ **Be a Good Citizen**
With everyone following the guidelines and rules set forth, we are able to provide a safe and fun golf experience. If patrons do not observe these rules, the course may close or further restrict access to all golfers

How WE are keeping you SAFE

- ✓ **Operations**
We are back to business as usual. Staff are required to stay home if they are ill or in contact with someone who is ill. All golfers are required to check-in at the Golf Shop for their scheduled tee time.
- ✓ **Extra Enforcement of Hygiene**
Staff are upping their hand washing and frequently disinfecting common touch points and on course washrooms.
- ✓ **Hours of Operation**
Tee times will be available 6am – 6:00pm daily. Golf course closes at the posted closing time daily. You will need to be off the course at that time. Hours subject to change.
- ✓ **Outside Food and Beverage**
Is not permitted. No tailgating is allowed in the parking lot or group gatherings larger than 50 persons.
- ✓ **Please Note**
The Glenview Park District may adjust fees based on demand and to cover operational expenses under these limited play conditions.
